Purpose and scope

The purpose with this workshop is to continue the creative and informal forum established in the last year's SNCNW meeting in which researchers and practitioners in computer networking meet and exchange ideas. The main objective is to establish better contact between computer network researchers, practitioners and industry, and thus to help strengthen this field in Sweden.

The intent of the workshop is to give all research groups an opportunity to present their work. However, as an extension to last year's organisation, submitted papers will be subjected to a formal reviewing process. The aim is to ensure that the program reflects as much as possible of on-going national research and to give constructive feedback to the authors.

Areas of interest include, but are not limited to:

- Network architecture
- Transport protocols
- Routing protocols
- Cross-layer interaction
- Traffic measurement and analysis
- Network security
- New networking paradigms
- Overlay networks and peer-to-peer
- Networking business models
- Networking for small and embedded systems
- Sensor networks
- Wireless and mobile networks
- Application requirements

Submissions

Technical papers can either be presented orally or displayed as posters. The author should indicate his/her preference when submitting. If all presentation submissions can not be accommodated due to time constraints, some may be offered a poster display instead. All submissions should be in the form of short papers of maximum 3000 words (about 3-4 pages in double column format). All contributions should be submitted in Portable Document Format (PDF) through the EDAS conference administration system at <http://edas.info/Paper.cgi?c=4343>.

The preferred language of the workshop is English, so the written submissions should be in the English language. No copyright will be claimed by the workshop.
